Using skilful 'compare and contrast' what would you say to Filemoni? Should he come or should he stay?



Exploratory Environment

Dear Parents

We are about to start a new social studies Quest called 'Filemoni's Dilemma.' This unit of work has been developed here at Birkdale Intermediate. Our students work in pairs to answer the question posed in the scenario.

They search a multimedia resource called a Quest, listening to video interviews, reading newspaper articles and looking at photographs. The Quest is used to teach the Culture and Heritage section of the National Social Studies Curriculum. Our students look in depth at, 'Why and how individuals and groups sustain their culture and heritage.'

The students are being asked to decide whether Filemoni should come to New Zealand or stay in Samoa. Their work will be assessed on the strength of their argument.
