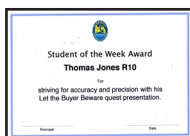


Positive Behaviour for Learning

The Best Choice

| Level 1 |
|--|
| <p>5 or 10 House Points</p> <p>My teachers will have many ways of saying well done.</p> <p>All my teachers will use house points.</p> <p>I could be given house points either 5 or 10.</p> <p>The points will be recorded on board and collected weekly.</p> |
| Level 2 |
| <p>20 House Points</p> <p>If Mr Coote puts a principal's award on my work.</p> <p>If I am presented with a student of the week or commendation certificate at assembly.</p> |
| Level 3 |
| <p>50 House Points</p> <p>If I am presented with a bronze, silver or gold principal's award at assembly.</p> <p>If I am presented with a sleeve badge at assembly.</p> <p>If I am presented with a gold school badge at assembly.</p> |
| Level 4 |
| <p>100 House Points</p> <p>If I am presented with a citizenship or achiever's badge at assembly.</p> |
| Level 5 |
| <p>Trophies and Awards</p> <p>I could be presented with a trophy or an award at an award assembly at the end of the year.</p> |

The Other Choice

| <p>Apology</p> <p>My teachers will have many ways of telling me how I can improve.</p> <p>They will always discuss the rule with me.</p> <p>I will apologise to anyone I have upset.</p> <p>A note will be made in the class incident book.</p> |
| Level 2 |
| <p>Detention</p> <p>I will stay in or spend time in the thinking area.</p> <p>A note will be made in the class incident book.</p> |
| Level 3 |
| <p>Other People Involved</p> <p>Our team leader will become involved.</p> <p>I may be withdrawn from class for a short period.</p> <p>My parents will be contacted by my teacher.</p> |
| Level 4 |
| <p>Behaviour Contract</p> <p>The deputy principal will become involved.</p> <p>I may be withdrawn from class for a period of time.</p> <p>I will be put on community service or a behaviour contract.</p> |
| Level 5 |
| <p>Privileges Withdrawn</p> <p>The principal will become involved.</p> <p>My parents will be called to a meeting at school.</p> <p>I will be withdrawn from school activities.</p> |

Serious incidents go straight to Level 5.
